BI-POLAR IONIZATION TECHNOLOGY

The presentation will review the principles of Bi-Polar Ionization (BPI) in nature, its applications and uses in indoor environments, its benefits to occupants in indoor spaces, as well as its overall benefits in improving indoor air quality and indoor environments.
