Directions:

South from Wilkes-Barre, take I-81 South to Nuangola exit (#159). At stop sign, make a left turn, and proceed 3/10 of a mile to next stop sign. Make right turn and proceed 1 mile to stop sign. Make a left turn and proceed 1.8 miles. At Prospect Road make a right turn and go 1.3 miles. At the intersection (Country Club Drive), make a left turn. Clubhouse will be on your right.

Coming West from Pocono/Allentown area, take I-80 West to exit #262, to Route 309. Take Route 309 North approximately 1.5 miles. Make a left turn, there will be a sign pointing to get to Interstate 81; go straight down mountain 3.1 miles. Make a sharp left turn. Proceed 1.6 miles, then make a right turn into the development. Continue straight 7/10 of a mile. Clubhouse will be on your left.

Traveling North or East, take I-81 North to exit #155 (Dorrance), make a right turn to "T" in road. Make a left turn, go 2.4 miles. Next make a sharp left turn and proceed 1.6 miles. Make a right turn into the development. Continue straight 7/10 of a mile. Clubhouse will be on your left.
