Pennsylvania Commercial Utilities Incentive Programs

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania utilities provide programs to assist customers in saving energy and reducing their utility costs. Whether your business is replacing an appliance with an ENERGY STAR model, upgrading your buildings core systems, installing solar, or building a whole new building – FirstEnergy has programs to help you save! Willdan is a contracted implementer for FirstEnergy in Pennsylvania, Maryland, and New Jersey. Willdan will present on the many programs available to help customers, and their engineering and design teams, make smart decisions about energy efficiency. For example, eligible HVAC upgrades and retrofits can receive \$1.85/kWh saved up to 80% of project cost through the Building Tune-Up program. This presentation will be specific to Pennsylvania, but there are similarities for those working on projects in Maryland and New Jersey.

Kevin is a professional with experience working for and with local and regional governments, non-profits, private businesses, utilities, and political campaigns. His work has centered on sustainability initiatives with tangible benefits to quality of life, economic opportunity, and environmental health. As the Senior Outreach Specialist for Willdan, Kevin educates FirstEnergy customers on utility incentives and creates value for them by connecting their energy and cost goals to tangible projects. Kevin also educates, recruits, and trains contractors who become the Program Allies that implement energy-saving projects. 


